The above patient has been under my care since _____. Due to the patient's hearing loss, the patient is likely to have trouble understanding instructions and teacher-directed discussion in the presence of background noise, competing conversation, poor acoustics, and/or reverberations in the classroom. In order to provide the patient with appropriate auditory signal in the classroom, it is recommended that the patient use an FM system. The use of an FM system will mitigate the negative effects of poor classroom acoustics and will allow for appropriate acoustic accessibility to classroom instruction. It is strongly recommended that the patient be provided with an FM system for the _____ ear(s) for classroom use. A Phonak inspire FM transmitter and iSense micro receiver are specifically recommended. When the FM transmitter is implemented, it is important to have an in-service orientation for the teachers and other school staff that come in contact with the device, so that the operation and maintenance of the device are clearly understood.
